



# Appeal to raise £154,000 for Archie's cancer treatment in America by October 2023



Archie is 4 years old, and his favourite things are Hot Wheels and Paw Patrol and listening to Marvin Gaye and Bobby Hebb songs. He is obsessed with numbers and maths and is such a kind and caring little boy.

In July 2022 Archie was diagnosed with high-risk neuroblastoma, a rare and aggressive childhood cancer that has a 40-50% chance of long-term survival at diagnosis.

Archie's parents are fundraising for a clinical trial in America that aims to reduce the chances of his neuroblastoma coming back.

Funds raised will go towards helping Archie and his family. If Archie no longer needs the funds or is in remission five years post the end of successful treatment, the funds will be used to support other children and families affected by neuroblastoma through Solving Kids' Cancer UK's activities. For children with high-risk neuroblastoma, like Archie, the survival rate is much lower than other childhood cancers. Upon relapse, this rate reduces even further. Solving Kids' Cancer UK is a registered charity in England and Wales 1135601, and in Scotland SCO45094.
