



Amelia is fighting a life-threatening cancer



Amelia is a kind and caring six-year-old from the West Midlands. Her favourite colours are pink and purple, and she loves exploring new places.

In September 2020, Amelia was diagnosed with high-risk neuroblastoma, an aggressive childhood cancer that has a 40-50% chance of long-term survival at diagnosis. After completing treatment in August 2022 and enjoying life, devastatingly scans showed her cancer had returned in April 2024.

Treating relapsed neuroblastoma successfully is particularly challenging and treatment options available on the NHS are limited. The family are fundraising should Amelia need potentially life-saving treatment to get her back into remission that is not available through the NHS.

Funds raised will go towards helping Amelia and her family. If Amelia no longer needs the funds or is in remission five years post the end of successful treatment, the funds will be used to support other children and families affected by neuroblastoma through Solving Kids' Cancer UK's activities. For children with high-risk neuroblastoma, like Amelia, the survival rate is much lower than other childhood cancers. Upon relapse, this rate reduces even further.
