Mikey loves cuddling up to watch Peppa Pig and playing with his little brother, Bobby. But this loving little toddler was diagnosed with high-risk neuroblastoma when he was just 20 months old.

He's already been through 8 rounds of chemotherapy and an 8-hour surgery, getting through treatment with his endless humour and cheeky personality!

Mikey's battle is far from over. The cancer will come back almost 50% of the time, so his family is raising funds to access further treatment not available on the NHS, to do everything to stop it returning.

This could cost hundreds of thousands of pounds.

If Mikey no longer needs the funds or is in remission 5 years post the end of successful treatment, the funds will be used to support other children and families affected by neuroblastoma through our activities. For children with high-risk neuroblastoma, like Mikey, the survival rate is much lower than other childhood cancers. Mikey has had 8 rounds of aggressive chemotherapy and an 8 hour surgery, along with other frontline treatment. He is currently accessing immunotherapy as the last stage.
