

Urgent appeal to raise £236,000 for Jasmine's cancer treatment in New York

Cheeky and loving 4-year-old Jasmine is a Princess to her parents and older brother. She loves dancing, music and everything to do with the movie 'Frozen'!

She was diagnosed with high-risk neuroblastoma in January 2018, an aggressive cancer that returns almost 50% of the time. Once it does, chances of survival drop to less than 1 in 10.

Jasmine's family are desperate to do all they can to give her the best chance of beating this awful disease. They want her to access treatment in New York which is showing promising results in reducing the likelihood of relapse, so she can live cancer-free.

Funds raised will go towards helping Jasmine and her family. If Jasmine no longer needs the funds or is in remission 5-years post the end of successful treatment, the funds will be used to support other children and families affected by neuroblastoma through our activities.



The fundraising target identified above combines the cost of treatment, the associated costs (e.g. travel and accommodation) as well as contingency for any unforeseen complications. For children with high-risk neuroblastoma, like Jasmine, the survival rate is much lower than other childhood cancers. Upon relapse, this rate reduces even further. Jasmine is hoping to access the Bivalent Vaccine clinical trial in New York as soon as she finishes frontline treatment.
